



EXERCISE ECG

DATE OF PROCEDURE	
TIME OF ARRIVAL AT THE RECEPTION DESK	

(The examination may be delayed because of the nature of the procedure.)

About the procedure:

During a standard exercise test, you walk on a treadmill. An electrocardiogram (ECG), arterial pressure and heart rate are recorded during the examination.

This examination can be paid for by the patient.

The procedure is carried out on the request of a physician.
Patients who register for an examination which they will pay for are asked to go to the Reception Desk of the Specialist Outpatient Care Department (Elevator 3, 1st floor) to make the payment and provide the necessary data.

HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT

Please bring your ECG, echocardiogram, and hospital discharge summary (cardiology reports), where applicable, with you to your scheduled appointment. You can eat a light breakfast on the day of your procedure, but do not perform any excessive physical exercise. Men should shave the upper portion of their chest. You may bring a workout outfit (shorts or sweatpants) and a towel.

Medications:

Take your medications according to your physician's instructions.

How to collect the results:

The examination report will be available 2 working days after the procedure.
Call 516 17 11 66 to find out whether your results are ready.

You can collect the results in person or with written authorization at the Hospital's Main Reception Desk (next to the reception officer suite) from Monday to Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. (until 6:00 p.m. on Thursdays).
